COURSE: We will pass through woods, wet areas, small hills, and cross several roads. We will keep the roads to a minimum, but your horse needs to be road safe and can be ridden safely in open country. Crossing guards will be provided at road crossings.

TEAMS: 2 to 6 riders. Organize your own team or we can match you up with a team.

There is NO order of go or assigned times.

ATTIRE: hard hats and English or Western saddle required

COST: \$25.00 entry fee with applications postmarked by Saturday, May 30.

\$30.00 late entry fee after Sunday, May 31, 2009.

Rain date will be Sunday, June, 28.

COGGINS FROM 2009 REQUIRED WITH ENTRY BLANK

FOOD: Delicious hot sandwiches, snacks and drinks will be available. A plate lunch costing \$5.00 will include a hamburger/brat/hot dog chips, cookie, and a drink.

The object of the poker ride is to collect a total of five playing cards, which are given out at various check points throughout the trail. When finished with your ride, you will give all five cards to the PIT BOSS who will then register your hand accordingly. **There will be a grand prize for the rider that pulls the "Joker's Wild" card.** Prizes will be given to the best hands pertaining to the rules of poker. We will try to give everyone a gift.

DIRECTIONS: From 1-94 exit at County G and go east. Go through the village of Caledonia and turn right on county H, go 1/2 mile and turn left on 5 Mile Rd. Continue east. There will be a stop sign on Nicholson Rd, a stop sign on Hwy 38, cross the bridge, and go 1 mile to Short Rd. Turn right and go 1/2 mile into the driveway at the top of the hill. Parking will be in the field.
